## Definitions:

**Wellness Exam:** Includes an assessment of overall body condition and health. Includes examining eyes, teeth, heart, lungs and abdomen. Examination of skin and other areas as deemed necessary. Guidance on nutrition and worming.

**Soundness Assessment:** Includes exam of horse trotting on hard surface to evaluate possible lameness issues. If lameness is detected, secondary lameness workup (not covered by plan) may be required.

**Fecal Floatation:** Exam of horse's manure for evidence of intestinal parasites.

**Blood Profile and CBC:** Blood profile uses enzyme levels to evaluate organ functions (kidney, liver, electrolytes and muscle dysfunction). CBC checks for anemia and infectious processes and white blood cell disorders.

## Deworming Packages

Parasites are particularly dangerous for horses. Keeping up with what to deworm with, and when to deworm is often a challenge for horse owners. With that in mind, we have developed two different deworming packages to meet your particular needs. Once you choose the package that is right for you, either rotational paste wormers or daily dosing, a year's worth of deworming products will be sent to you labeled and ready for use. No more trying to remember what you used last and when. These products are also offered to you at a substantial savings. You will receive a year's worth of dewormer at the first visit.

Yearly fees are due at the time of enrollment and based on the packages you choose. In order to provide the cost savings to you, the Wellness Program payment must be made at the time of enrollment.

**Renewals:** This program automatically renews each year unless you contact us to cancel your participation. You may enroll at anytime during the year.

**Refunds:** Pro-rated refunds will be made in the event of death of an enrolled horse. The program may also be transferred to another horse of the same owner, or to the new owner of a sale horse that remains in our practice area.
